The KLE Engineering College, Chikkodi, in association with the Taluka Legal Services Authority and the Lawyers' Association, Chikkodi, organized a program to observe the **International Day Against Drug Abuse**.

The event was inaugurated by **S.L. Chavan**, Honorable 7th Additional District and Sessions Judge, Belagavi Bench, Chikkodi. In his address, he emphasized:

"The progress of a nation lies in the hands of its youth. It is disheartening to see college students falling prey to drug addiction. In our country, there are strict laws regarding narcotics and drugs. While anyone can purchase medicines, buying or possessing narcotics is a crime. Often, drug use begins at parties and later becomes an addiction, leading to crimes and even suicides. Parents at home and teachers in schools should keep a close watch on their children."

Sri Chidanand Badiger, Honorable Principal Civil Judge and Judicial Magistrate, said:

"Youth is a turbulent phase of life. Lack of self-control during this time can lead to bad habits. Some individuals initially indulge in these habits for style but later become addicts. A disciplined approach during youth paves the way for a stable and successful future."

Sri Harish Patil, Honorable Principal Civil Judge and Chairman of the Legal Services Authority, Chikkodi, remarked:



"The misuse of narcotic substances has led to their strict regulation. Adolescents often lack maturity and, out of curiosity or for entertainment, fall into addiction. The drug trade is a global business worth 3,000 billion. If not controlled, it could have catastrophic consequences worldwide."

M.B. Patil, a panel advocate, added:

"Teenage is often referred to as the 'monkey age.' Overcoming addiction requires at least four years of treatment, along with love and friendship. Cultivate human values to bring about positive change. If drugs are not controlled, it will lead the nation toward decline."

Presiding over the event, **Dr. Prasad Rampure**, Principal of KLE Engineering College, Chikkodi, noted:

"Today, children are becoming addicted to online gaming and social media through mobile phones. The usage of these should be balanced. Have a goal in life and work hard to achieve it; this will reduce the chances of falling into addiction."
